

HAZARDOUS WASTE PHARMACEUTICAL

APPLIES TO HEALTHCARE FACILITIES

- Includes hospitals, ambulatory surgery centers, health clinics, physician s offices, and pharmacies.

cannot be used again, is expired, damaged, or otherwise ineligible for credit through reverse distribution.

- A waste pharmaceutical is hazardous if it is listed on the U or P lists (40 CFR 261.33) or if it exhibits a hazardous characteristic such as ignitable, corrosive, reactive, or toxic (40 CFR 261.21-24).

STORAGE & LABELING

- Accumulate non-creditable pharmaceutical waste in a compatible, closed container labeled Hazardous Pharmaceutical Waste.
- Date the container when waste is first added and keep no more than one year.
- creditable pharmaceutical waste

EMPTY CONTAINERS

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DISPOSAL

- Hazardous waste pharmaceuticals (HWP) cannot be discharged to the sanitary sewer.
- USF s selected vendor picks up hazardous waste pharmaceuticals for disposal.
