SUBJECT: USF Police Investigate Sexual Battery

On Saturday, July 29, 2017, at approximately 1:00 p.m., the University of South Florida Police Department received notification of a possible sexual battery that occurred on the USF Tampa Campus at the Greek Village Building J between the hours of 1:00 AM and 3:30 AM.

The USF Police initiated an investigation into the allegations. The victim and suspect were both attendees at a party held in the building. No physical injuries were reported to police. This is an active criminal investigation.
