Work with individuals who are addicted to drugs and alcohol in various stages of recovery process

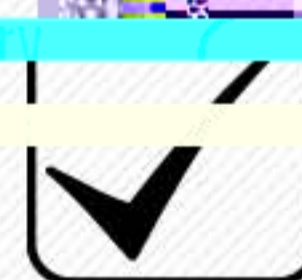

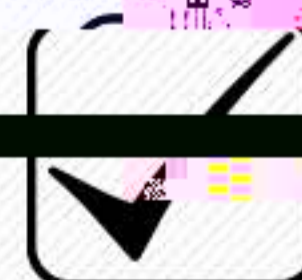
