

Guidelines for Documenting Traumatic Brain Injury

Students seeking support services from the University of South Florida on the basis of a previously diagnosed Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) are requested to submit documentation that verifies their eligibility under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and the ADA Amendments Act. The documentation should describe a disabling condition, which is defined by the presence of substantial limitations in one or more major life activities. The guidelines are intended to provide guidance for the assessment process, including the areas that should be assessed in order for staff to make appropriate decisions. Students submitting documentation. Detailed

background information could include any pertinent medical, psychological and learning disability history, and a discussion of dual diagnosis, if present; this includes a history of any coexisting disorders that could affect functioning.
